

AIHC Interprofessional Educator and Mentor Award

Description: This award recognizes individuals who demonstrate excellence in interprofessional teaching and mentorship.

Eligibility: Members of AIHC with minimum of two years membership.

Nature of the award:

- Certificate of Award
- One year free membership to AIHC.

The award will be publically acknowledged at national and international conferences such as the Nexus Summit and Collaborations Across Borders.

Application/Nomination Procedures:

1. Chair of the AIHC scholarship committee will call for nominations.
2. Self, peer or student nominations are accepted.
3. The AIHC scholarship awards subcommittee will review nominations and determine the award recipient.
4. The following should be provided in the application consisting of eight pages or less:
 - Cover page
 - Two letters of support and one letter from students/mentees
 - Description of interprofessional education and/or mentorship provided for the past 2 years
 - Previous award recognitions in teaching and/or mentoring.
 - Evidence for exemplary teaching or mentoring and role model for interprofessional collaboration as identified by the following selection criteria.

Selection Criteria:

- Quality of letters of support that highlight exemplary interprofessional teaching with evidence for developing excellent interprofessional education experiences and/or curricula.
- Quality of letters of support that highlight exemplary mentoring for health professions students.

- Evidence of role modeling interprofessional competencies of collaboration, teamwork, communication and respect.
