

## **AIHC Scholarship Award**

**Description:** This award is given to recognize and reward individuals who have made significant contributions to research and scholarship in interprofessional practice and education.

**Eligibility:** Members of AIHC with a minimum of two year memberships.

**Nature of award:**

- Certificate
- One year free membership to AIHC

The award will be publically acknowledged at national and international conferences such as the Nexus Summit and Collaborations Across Borders.

**Application/Nomination Procedure:**

1. Chair of the AIHC scholarship committee will call for nominations.
2. Self or peer nominations are accepted.
3. The AIHC scholarship awards subcommittee will review nominations and determine the award recipient.
4. The following should be provided in the application consisting of eight pages or less:
  - Cover page
  - Two letters of support
  - Description of research and scholarship in interprofessional practice and education disseminated in the last 2 years. Scholarship consistent with definition by Boyer<sup>1</sup>, such as discovery, integration, application and teaching and learning, is appropriate.
    - Grant submissions and awards
    - Presentations to IPE conferences including invites
    - Peer-reviewed and non-peer reviewed publications

**Selection Criteria:**

- Research/scholarly productivity including peer-reviewed publications and presentations
- Quality of research/scholarship
- Internal/external funding support
- Impact of scholarship in advancing IPE and collaborative practice

### Assessment Rubric
