

Student Award for Interprofessional Collaborative Practice

Description:

This award is given to a student who has demonstrated consistent engagement in an interprofessional collaborative practice within the clinic, classroom and/or community.

Eligibility:

1. AIHC student member.
2. Faculty, peer or self-nominations accepted.

Application:

Should a student wish to be considered for this award they must:

- A. Submit two letters of support. One letter must be from a faculty member. The second may be from a fellow student or self-nomination for this award to include the procedure criteria listed below.
- B. The nominated student must submit an electronic poster to include the criteria below for award consideration.
- C. Nominations will be se

Nomination Procedure/Criteria:

1. The Chair of the AIHC Scholarship Committee will call for nominations.
2. Nomination by Faculty, Mentor or Fellow Student are accepted.
3. Nominations will then be sent on to the Awards Subcommittee for review and award recipient decision.
4. Submission of two letters of support from faculty. Letters must include the following criteria:
 - Description of engagement [project, mentorship, clinical or community experience] in interprofessional collaborative practice.
 - Description of outcomes and/or impact on the clinic, classroom and/or community.
 - Evidence of demonstrating interprofessional communication, collaboration and excellence as team member.
5. Electronic Poster to be submitted by the nominated student.

Include the following criteria in the electronic poster:

- Description of engagement [project, mentorship, clinical or community experience] in interprofessional collaborative practice.
- Description of outcomes and/or impact on the clinic, classroom and/or community.
- Reflection on lessons learned about interprofessional collaborative practice.
- Description of how experience will impact your future practice.

Award

- Certificate of Award
- One year free membership to AIHC
- The award will be publically acknowledged at a national conference such as Nexus or Collaborations Across Borders.
